Since 2016, Mark has been partnering with offsite factory <u>Kodasema.com</u> and <u>kodea.eu</u> for creating sustainable module units for making change in the construction industry.

Mark has been in a long-term relationship with singer and actress Kärt Tomingas for many years. The couple has a daughter, Roberta, and currently live in Lääne-Viru County. Mark also has a son Ailan Daniel from a previous marriage.
